To All Parent/Carers of children born between 1 September 2020 and 31 August 2021

Dear Parent/Carer



If your child was born between 1 September 2020 and 31 August 2021, they are due to start school for the first time (Reception Year) in September 2025. Parents/carers must apply to the local authority in which they live (pay council tax to) even if they would like to apply for a school in another local authority area. We co-ordinate the allocation of places with other local authorities to ensure that you will only receive one offer of a place at a school.

It is important to apply now for a place at primary school. Attendance at a nursery or pre-school does not automatically mean that a place will be allocated at an associated primary school, nor does it guarantee your child a place. You need to complete and submit an application, stating your preferred schools, to be considered for the allocation of a primary school place for September 2025.

## How do I apply?

You can make your **Starting School for the First Time 2025** application online from **7 November 2024** via the North East Lincolnshire Parent's Portal which you can access at:

www.nelincs.gov.uk/children-families-and-schools/schools-and-education/school-admissions/apply-for-aschool-place/.

All parent/carers are advised to register and apply online as this will allow immediate confirmation of your application submission to the School Admissions Team. You will also receive quicker notification of your school place decision by email/via your Parent Portal account on National Offer Day.

<u>Please note</u>: if you have registered or made past applications through the previous "Citizen's Portal", this system has now closed so you can no longer use Citizen Portal accounts to make an application.

For those unable to apply online, please use the paper Common Application Form (CAF) which can be downloaded to print off from our website or can be requested from your child's nursery, from the school office of your preferred primary school or directly from the School Admissions team.

## When do I need to apply?

The online application process for Starting School for the First Time – September 2025 opens on **7 November 2024**. The submission deadline for applications to be considered "on-time" is **15 January 2025** (this is the National closing date after which any submitted applications may not be considered in the first round of school place allocation).

Please note that it is the parent/carers' responsibility to ensure that their application has reached the School Admissions team by the closing date.

## What happens if I apply late?

The closing date for "on-time" applications is **15 January 2025**. The new Parent Portal will allow applications to be submitted online after the closing date however, (without good reason for late submission) these will not be considered until after the first round of school place allocations.



## How many schools can I apply for?

You can apply for a place at up to three schools of your preference. Please ensure that you list your selection of schools in preference order, with most desired first. If you are wanting to apply for any schools outside of North East Lincolnshire, you must include these in your list of preferences on your application.

### IMPORTANT - Preferences for SCARTHO GATEWAY / WALTHAM GATEWAY ACADEMY new schools

If you are selecting either of the Scartho Gateway Academy or Waltham Gateway Academy new schools as a preference on your application, please ensure that you add at least one other preference of school below this. This will allow us to consider a backup preference of school in the event that the new school constructions are not complete for September 2025 admissions.

# What happens if I change address after I submit my application?

If you/your child changes home address after you make your application, you will need to contact the School Admissions team so that this can be amended. You will need to provide evidence of your new address in one of the accepted forms below:

- Council Tax Bill at the new address
- Recent utility bill
- · Recent child tax credit letter
- Current driving licence
- Solicitors letter of completion (for a house purchase)
- Signed and dated tenancy agreement (for a property rental)

You can submit a copy of the relevant document (scan or clear digital photograph) with your online application or email to us at <a href="mailto:schooladmissions@nelincs.gov.uk">schooladmissions@nelincs.gov.uk</a> Please include your child's name and date of birth with any submission so that it can be attached to the correct school application.

# How and when will I receive my child's school allocation decision?

Applicants who apply on-time and via the Parent Portal will receive their allocation decision by email on National Primary Offer Day, 16 April 2025. Parent Portal applicants will also be able to check their allocation on their Portal account

Applicants who apply on-time through any other method (e.g. paper CAF) will receive their allocation decision by Second Class letter to their home address, issued on 16 April 2024.
